REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Students applying must study piano with a current member of the Asheville Area Piano Forum.
- 2) Student applicants should demonstrate commitment to piano study by participating in a performance event. Examples of these events are the Asheville Piano Competition, AAPF Student Recitals, teacher recitals, and NCMTA Performance Festival. Comment sheets or recital programs should be used for documentation. The applicant or teacher must send copies of the documentation to the Student Assistance (SA) Chairperson by the **May 31st** deadline.
- 3) **Financial Need** must be demonstrated by the parent or guardian's submission of one of the following items: the first two pages of the most recent Federal Income Tax Return; a copy of medicaid card; **or**, proof of free and reduced lunch. Include a statement describing the family's financial need and send the information to the SA Chairperson by the May 31st deadline.
Note: Private financial information remains confidential with the SA committee and will be destroyed following action by that committee.
- 4) The applicant's piano teacher is to fill out and submit the **Teacher Evaluation Form** to the SA Committee Chairperson by the **May 31st Deadline**.
